Welcome everyone to our 20th IWFFA Ptown Classic!

I want to thank the Provincetown community, businesses, Provincetown Tourism and Provincetown Parks & Rec in welcoming us all these years, allowing us to host the IWFFA Ptown Classic for 20 years.

Special welcome to our athletes here for the first time and our newest team: Artemis A O. I hope you love this event and come back for more as well compete in other IWFFA tournaments around the world, throughout the year. The philosophy of the IWFFA is to play one's best versus playing to win. Play to have fun, make friends and help one another. We use flag football as a vehicle to unite women around the world and to build female leaders to make a better world. For this alone, we are a very special woman's organization. Notice during the competition clean play and wonderful camaraderie, which you may not think possible in a semi-contact sport, but we have built this unity through the IWFFA philosophy and our tournament social events.

It's been a busy year for the IWFFA. With the inclusion of 5 on 5 style flag football in the 2028 Olympics, 7's in Universities, we felt it very important to continue to build our 8 on 8 style of play. We've been promoting our game from February to August around the world in: Guatemala, Honduras, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Mexico, Arizona and the east coast of the USA from Miami to Vermont. We are working it! We created a Junior Division for girls ages, 12 - 15 yr old, in all of Central America. We started up new women's teams and next year we go to new countries: Costa Rica and Kenya, as well as continue to develop a Brooklyn Women's Flag Football League. Make sure to read our IWFFA flag football news on the first of each month to keep up and participate in our IWFFA activities. Now that your an IWFFA member, you will receive the monthly flag football news directly to your email box.

Look at our Itinerary in this program for this year's events and join in! I am grateful to those teams

who joined us early Friday for some Kickball action. This Kickball event is also a fundraiser for our Nicaragua Junior team. Throughout the tournament we will be selling 50/50 raffle tickets, boxes, and tee shirts. All proceeds go to our girls' flag football programs around the world. Please support the girls as they are our future flag football women.

This year our Women Speaker Series takes place at: St. Mary of Harbor Church on Friday beginning at 4:30PM. We have prominent speakers from a variety of countries who will share some amazing stories from their life experiences. Please read in this program under: Who's Who about our speakers: Anu Avani (India), Zeba Hussain (Pakistan), Gabriela DeCosta (Honduras) and Elise Montalvan (El Salvador).

Friday night is final tournament registration (all players must attend) at Harbor Lounge. Saturday night is the women's party at Shipwreck Lounge at Brass Key Inn. Sunday awards will be held at Harbor Hotel. Every registered player receives a free bicycle rental from our main sponsor: The Bike Shack. You'll find Ptown is easy to get around (no need to take your cars). Show your IWFFA membership card to pick up your bike. On Monday, we offer a bike tour through the Dunes, so keep your bikes till then. We will end the long weekend with a tournament dinner at Fanizzi's Restaurant Monday night.

This Ptown Classic will be our 20th anniversary. The first tournament in 2003, was named after famous comedian Kate Clinton: The Kate Clinton Classic. In that first year we had 4 teams: RI Hurricanes (split in 2 teams to make a better competition), RI Thunder, Quebec Canada, and the Salty's Ptown Loose Women team. This year we were close to having 10 teams and if we had 10 teams, with 1 field (no more Jerome field), we would have to fit more games in our schedule which meant either we: play early to late on Saturday and Sunday, or we begin on Friday and make the IWFFA Ptown Classic a 3 day flag football competition. We are sure next year we will bring more teams to the competition, so we will discuss this situation at the team captains meeting at Friday night registration.

For tournament play, we have a brand new Motta Field! Bathrooms will not be ready for our tournament, so we will still have to use a Porto-potty for one more year. In this case, we will get 2 porta-potties (remember last year?). There are 8 teams (in alphabetical order) 518 All Stars - Artemis AO - Blue Wave - Dimes - Dolphins - First Order - Loose Women - RI Hurricanes. The tournament has 2 divisions: Higher and Lower which will be decided by playing a 2 game separation round on Saturday. Sunday the divisions are separated, and the tournament becomes single elimination at that time. Games on Saturday will be slotted 1.10 hr. (because they can end up in a tie). Sunday games will be slotted 1.5 hr. (we need a winner and may have to go into overtime). Half time games will be played during the first 4 games on Sunday. When you see me come to the middle of the field at the end of each game, come on out to join the competitions. Some of the contests will be: furthest throw, 3 legged race, wheel barrel, etc. - prizes to winners sponsored by Toys of Eros. Our officials this year are: Renee and Mark Walker (sister & brother) and Georgeann Lewis (head official USA). They do a great job in officiating and we are grateful to have them here. Don't forget to rank them on your score cards.

Something I ask from all our teams and fans is to support those who supported us. Look at all the businesses who are in this tournament program and when you decide where to eat, where to stay, what to do, please support these businesses you see in this program who supported us.

This tournament does not run on it's own. There have been hard working persons, volunteers who have made it possible. Thank you to: Rosaria Baldari, Celia Arevelo, Andrea Parker, Gabriela Dacosta, Elise Montalvan, Zeba Hussain, Marianne Nelson and all those who will help out at the tournament for we know many will jump in to do just that.

I thank you for coming, for being here to compete in our 20th IWFFA Ptown Classic, and for sharing your good spirit, good energy and flag football talents with us all. May you learn some great plays, new skills, have fun, play your best flag football ever and make lot's of new friends.

Who's Competing This year

518 All Stars - Is a women's flag football team made up of athletes from throughout the Capital Region of Albany, NY, and surrounding areas. The team is primarily composed of current and former women's tackle football players from the NY Knockout, along with talented local athletes who specialize in flag football. United by their love of the game, 518 All Stars competes, connects, and grows women's football.

Artemis AO - Our newest team in the tournament, is a women's travel flag football team based in New York's Hudson Valley, creating new opportunities for women outside of NYC to compete at a high level. AO stands for "All Over", reflecting a roster that welcomes athletes from across the region and beyond. The team takes its name for Artemis, the Greek goddess and fierce protector of women and the wild - a master of the bow and arrow known for demanding respect and being ruthless when her boundaries are crossed. That same strength, independence, and protective spirit define Artemis AO.

Loose Women - A very special team indeed. The Loose women are an assortment, some experienced flag football players, some brand new to the sport who have joined together for the challenge of playing in this tournament. The IWFFA offers this team for those women who do not have their own team, or to those who have just found out about the tournament and would like to give the sport a try. The Loose Women team roster remains open throughout the tournament and anyone can join during the games. If the team falls below 10 players, they are allowed to borrow from the other competing teams so they have 10 players (sound crazy?). Winning does not matter, instead playing one's best, making friends and having fun is the main emphasis.

Blue Wave - Was founded by Coach Eduardo Gonzalez in 2002 as an intramural team at Florida Tech in Melbourne, Florida. We began competing in IWFFA tournaments in 2005 and have been on the field every year since. We believe every woman who wants to play football should have the opportunity, regardless of background, age, or previous experience. We pride ourselves on competitive play, sportsmanship, and being positive role models for the young

girls and women coming into the sport. Our commitment to community extends beyond the field. Each November, we host our annual Turkey Bowl tournament, collecting food and monetary donations for a local food bank.

The Dimes - Champs in last year's 19th IWFFA Ptown Classic in the higher division. The Dimes are a Boston based flag football team that compete in BW & FFL!

New England Dolphins - For more than 3 years, the New England Dolphins have been more than just a flag football team—we've become a family.

Through wins and losses, celebrations and challenges, we've continued to show up for one another, both on and off the field. We've built friendships, shared countless laughs, supported each other through the ups and downs, and created memories that go far beyond the game. What makes the Dolphins special isn't just the talent on the field—it's the trust, loyalty, friendship, and bond we've built over the years. We play for each other, encourage each other, and never let one another face a challenge alone. We're still chasing the next win, still having fun, and still standing together as one team, one family. Once a Dolphin, always a Dolphin.

Rhode Island Hurricanes - A team put together each year specifically for the Ptown tournament. It is primarily formed from players in the Rhode Island Women's Flag Football Association (RIWFFA) with some help from friends outside our league as well. It's a fun time to merge people from different teams in the league to be able to play together.

First Order - More than a football team we're a family.

First Order is built on positivity, fun, friendly competition, and creating lasting connections both on and off the field. We welcome players of all skill levels and provide a supportive environment where everyone has the opportunity to learn, grow, compete, and simply enjoy the game.

We believe football is about more than wins and losses. It's about teamwork, friendships, making memories, traveling together, supporting one another, and becoming better as a team. Come for the football. Stay for the family.

Women Speaker Series

Last year's speakers came from Afghanistan. They were one of the families whom the IWFFA, along with ALDEA and Greenberg Traurig law firms got asylum for. They shared some great stories. This year, we will not let you down. Our players come from a variety of countries and will share a part of their life experiences with us. Our Speakers are from four different countries: India, Pakistan, El Salvador and Honduras.

Zeba Hussain - Pakistan Ambassador &

Regional Director for Asia

I am Zeba Hussain and feel really proud to introduce myself as a Pakistan woman flag football representative and Asian representative. This game was introduced to me by a man who was a football player in Pakistan. I don't want to mention the name of this person, but I do remember that this same person didn't want me to be in charge or in leadership of the women flag football. There were times this man tried to demonize me and separate me from the IWFFA.

I need to explain that in Asia, there is not a single game which is led by a woman. IWFFA Flag football is the first game of the world in which a woman is leading and it's very much inspiring for all of us, especially for younger girls who want to pursue their careers in this sport and become inspiration for other fellow nation girls. We should work together to introduce the world that women can be a leader.

Elisa Chávez García - El Salvador - is a passionate flag football leader, coach, referee, and advocate for the growth of women's and girls' flag football in Latin America.

For Elisa, flag football is much more than a game. It is a platform for empowerment, friendship, personal growth, leadership, and community. Her vision is to continue creating opportunities for women and girls in El Salvador and throughout Latin America to play, compete, lead, and discover their own potential through the sport.

Esther Gabriela Dacosta Garcia - Honduras - Will speak about being a woman in Honduras

Being a woman in Honduras has shaped who I am in ways I never fully understood until I began looking back at my journey. It has taught me resilience, courage, and the importance of finding my own voice.

We are raised surrounded by strong women—mothers, grandmothers, sisters, daughters—who often carry families, overcome obstacles, and keep moving forward even when life is difficult.

Flag Football Players in CUBA

In 2015, the IWFFA traveled to Cuba and introduced the sport starting one woman's team. Today, we have over 40 female flag football players who are young girls, juniors and women. Almost every year, we travel to Cuba for flag football friendship games and bring hundreds of pounds of food, clothing and medical supplies (you are invited to join us June 3 - 7, 2027).

But now our Cuban flag football players need our help. Getting food in Cuba has become such a crisis that we have been asked to help. There is a food company who can deliver food to our players. Recently, the IWFFA has sent hundreds of dollars of food to our players, but they will need to be replenished in the near future.

International Women Flag Football Association (IWFFA)

A 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization doing miracle work all around the world using flag football as its vehicle. The first of many: first national women's flag football association (1995), received the National Sports Emmy Award for NFL Documentary: Football America (1996), first international women flag football association (1997), has promoted and introduced the sport in dozens of countries around the world. In 2001, held the largest women's flag football tournament in the world with 48 teams of women (9 were international) and 1,243 female athletes at the Kelly McGillis Classic. In the same year planted the seed for women's tackle football helping to establish the sport. The IWFFA partnered with ALDEA and Greenberg Traurig to get asylum for 73 Afghanistan flag football women and their families out of Afghanistan to Mexico (2022). From this effort, the IWFFA officially became not only a woman's organization, but a humanitarian one. Almost every year, the IWFFA travels to Cuba to bring hundreds of pounds of food, clothing and medical supplies to our flag football players. We travel girls from the poorest communities to compete in international tournaments. Helped to establish the Junior Division for girls flag football in Central America. And we're just getting started! "We promote, we organize, we build female flag football around the world building female leaders. An organization run by women". Diane Beruldsen – President / Founder of the IWFFA

A Million Miler Traveler for women's flag football, who recently received award from the: National Football Foundation as the "Mother of Flag Football". Playing flag football since the 70's and organizing since 1979 teams, leagues and associations. Her ultimate goal is to offer flag football to all the girls around the world for free, starting with girls in the poorest communities. Diane sees the power of unity, as the IWFFA got asylum for 73 Afghanistan flag football women and their families in 2022. There is nothing we can't do.

Officiating Crew - This year's officiating crew is comprised of a brother and sister and head Official for U.S.A.

Mark Walker - has been officiating for the IWFFA since 2010. You will hear Mark at a distance and is recognized for his penalty calling. Renee Walker started out as a player and first joined the IWFFA in 1998 as a competitive athlete on, then In 2013, she changed her uniform for stripes. Georgeann Lewis, also started out as a competitive athlete back in 1998 and both female officials played for RI Hurricanes. Georgeann started to officiate, when I don't know, but she became the IWFFA Head Official in 2024. This year we have a strong & talented officiating crew.

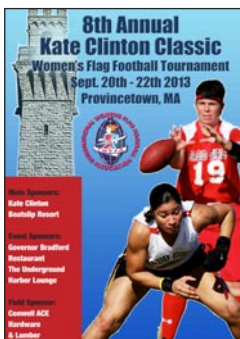
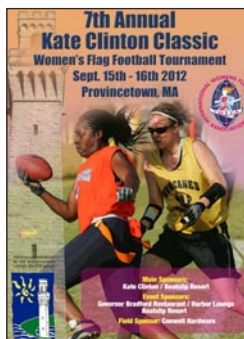
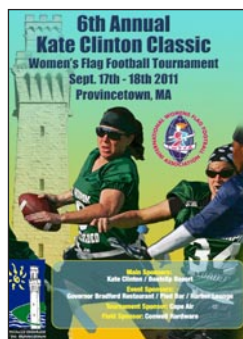
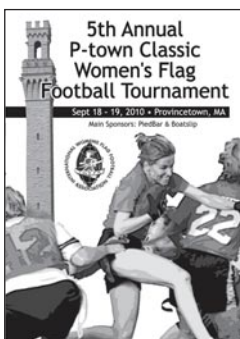
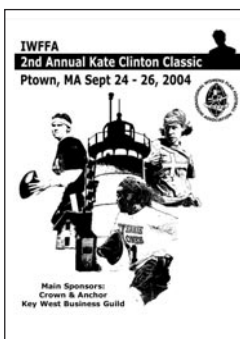
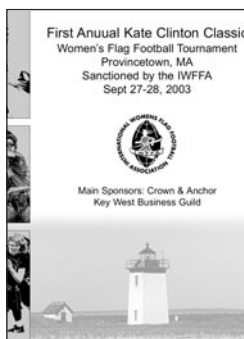

We ask when you rate each referee's performance during the game please use their names. Renee, Georgeann, Mark. You can also make comments about the tournament.

Information Table - At the field, check in arriving & leaving the field for updated information. Captains p/u your score cards & return soon after each game. lost & found, programs, merchandise, equipment, 50/50, Champ game boxes are here.

Pre-Game Player Check - Teams must line up on side line - for player check 10 Minutes before game time: roster & equipment check, make sure all your players are regis-

tered, shirt #'s are correct. pockets NOT allowed but can be taped.

Player Eligibility - The tournament will keep rosters handy at the field in case there is a dispute for an illegal player. Any concerns about an opposing team using an ineligible player may be brought up with tournament director and roster will be checked immediately. Pennies 3 ineligible linewoman must be designated, can wear Mesh pennies or different shirt color from team.

Purchase Equipment - Notify IWFFA before the tournament. Dozen Flag A Tag Belts \$60 / Wilson All Leather. Premium Jr. Size Standard Ball with IWFFA logo - \$75 per. Contact office 1 week before tournament. IWFFA@IWFFA.COM

Goal Posts - We will rig goal posts - 2 x 4's to soccer goals - field goals, extra point kicks are options during the game.

All Star Nominations for each Division – Team captains will receive an All Star Sheet for notes. When tournament is over, each team captain (1) & coach (1), or (2) captains will meet to discuss & agree on tournament all stars. All teams in each division must be included and represented in final All Star pics

Special privilege for the Loose Women's Team - Read in IWFFA rules - Loose Women's team is a special team for IWFFA. It invites individual players, women playing for the first time, and is allowed to borrow players from other teams, up to 10 total players. They can come from any team in any division. Game scores count.

The National Football Foundation Southern Arizona Chapter is proud to support, recognize and celebrate excellence. We celebrate Diane Beruldsen.

In the 1950s, Porter Wilson organized and standardized flag football rules, developed and patented "Sonic Boom" belts and is credited with initiating flag football in Southern Arizona.

Diane Beruldsen is the "mother of flag football." In 1997 she founded the International Women's Flag Football Association ("IWFFA"), taking a grassroots regional group in New York and creating the first international women's flag football association, building it from the ground up, piece by piece.
