

#### LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT



WELCOME TO KEY WEST! TO ALL OUR PLAYERS - TEAMS - FANS

Some have traveled two and a half days around

the world to get here. Most are coming from the cold with snow, entering into our hot tropical climate which can be overbearing. All of the teams have had to do lots of fundraising to afford the hotels and travel. Some have had to apply for visas to enter the United States. You all worked hard to be here and congratulations, because some were not so fortunate. Carlos Fanjul who works for the office of U.S. Representative: Congressman Carlos Gimeniz, was contacted last summer by the IWFFA in order to aid and support our international teams. From then, I was emailing, phoning him and this year we had much success and will have teams from: Morocco, Honduras, Jamaica and Spain, due to the efforts of Mr. Carlos Fanjul. Unfortunately, our players from Pakistan and India were not successful. And to those who wanted to come, but could not, we are truly sorry and will miss you.

For this reason, the IWFFA has organized new events and tournaments in other regions of the world, making it possible for female teams to compete. We've added tournaments in: Jamaica, Honduras, Mexico, Pakistan and Spain (see their dates in our tournament page in this program). We will have our very first IWFFA FLAG FOOTBALL FESTIVAL in El Salvador, April 10 - 17th, where players will come with their tents and sleeping bags and participate in women's workshops to empower the female spirit, and also to strengthen your flag football skills with clinics for every flag football position. I ask the Americans to look at our international tournaments and bring your team to compete.

So Covid is still with us, and it just may be that at the time of our games, all athletes may be required to wear masks. We have to wait and see if there will be these mandatory regulations. Those persons who have not gotten their COVID vaccination, will definitely have to wear a mask when they are playing on the field and we ask you to keep 6 feet distance from others. This year, everyone will have to show their vaccination card at the registration along with your photo I.D. when

you sign your team roster to register for the tournament. Your roster will be noted, and monitored during all games.

Last year was suppose to be the 30th Kelly McGillis Classic, however, due to Covid, teams outside Monroe County were not allowed to compete. For that reason, this year will be the "Official" 30th Kelly McGillis Classic and with so many international teams, the World Challenge IX Game will take place. The world challenge is the USA all stars vs the International all stars and is the very last game of the long weekend. Currently, USA is ahead by one point. The score is 4 to 3 and this year, the international teams have the opportunity to tie. Save you juice for the Challenge IX Game, all divisions are included for athlete picks. Tell us before the tournament starts if you are vying to be on the world challenge team for either side.

I want to thank Kelly McGillis for all these years of endorsing the event and allowing the IWFFA to use her name which has brought great media exposure. Her daughters played, Kelly played on the loose women's team and every year she is here, we have special events such as: "So you think you can act", monologues, and then some crazy events like "win a date with Kelly". This year we thought her fans would enjoy to just sit down and listen to her as she shares her stories of becoming an actress and then the challenges of being one. Tuesday, from 4-5:30 you can also ask questions.

This year we lost a good one. Marcia Root. She was our most reliable volunteer, from merchandise woman to registration woman, to whatever we needed woman. She passed away on August 10, 2021, and we have a special award this year and every year to remember her by. It will go to one of the volunteers who works the hardest. Rest in peace Marcia.

End of August, 2021 was horrible for our IWFFA Afghan Women's Flag Football Association. This was the league we helped to start in 2018, by traveling to India to teach how to: play, coach and officiate the sport, so they could bring it back to Afghanistan. The women did, they started their league, coached, officiated and were playing until the end of August. It was then, when U.S.A. troops left the country, and the Taliban took over and began to search for women who





Our Monroe County schools girls flag football program was initiated in 2009 and supported by then Monroe County school Superintendent: Randy Acevedo. Today the program continues to receive support from Monroe County Schools and current School Superintendent: Theresa Axford. The girls division has since grown exponentially since it's beginning in 1999 and the IWFFA was not able to afford all it's girls teams. The "Team Owner" program opened the doors for all girls in the Florida Keys to play flag football for free by offering the opportunity to all schools in Monroe county to enter a team of girls to represent their school in the Kelly McGillis Classic tournament at no cost to the school or the players parents. What a wonderful opportunity to support the schools, parents and help to develop such fine female athletes. Schools from Key West to as far as Key Largo who will be competing in this year's tournament.

Each fall season, the IWFFA contacts local schools asking if they would like to participate in the girls flag football program. We then travel to the schools, offer flag football to the girls, and start up the school girls flag football team. We continue to coach the girls and juniors to get ready for the Kelly McGillis Classic Tournament and promote good quality flag football, teaching our young athletes to understandi the game, strategy and mechanics. For us winning is not emphasized, but rather camaraderie, understanding the game, over coming the challenging skills on the field, building leaders and having fun. It's a great program.

played sports in order to persecute them for breaking Taliban law. So now we are getting them out of Afghanistan and bringing them (40), into Key West where they will work and live. We want to thank: Isle Smile Dentist, Casa Marina Hotel, Ocean Key Hotel and Southernmost Hotel for willing to employ and house the Afghans. We are very proud and grateful to one of our own: Flag Football player and lawyer, Bridget Cambria. Bridget competed in the Kelly McGillis Classic back in 2010-2011 with the Rhode Island Hurricanes and she also answered our call for help in September 2021, when we emailed all our players asking for help to find a lawyer for the Afghans. Bridget emailed our office the very next day to tell us " I'm an immigration lawyer and I can help". The Afghans are not here yet, there is a long shot they may make it to Key West by end of January. And so far we have raised over \$11,000 for the Afghan evacuation. We invite you to make a donation towards this fundraiser, the IWFFA is a 501C3 non-profit organization, and your donation is tax deductible and ALL THE MONEY goes to the Afghans and their evacuation.

Finally, who are we? We are an organization run by women for women. We travel around the world introducing the sport in countries who never heard of flag football, creating leaders and putting the women in charge. We unite each country one by one. At this tournament, you should go over to women from other teams, buy her a beer or soda, and get to know your "flag football sister", cause we are family. We care for our athletes and function as a woman's organization using the sport of flag football as a vehicle. You are a member of all this. We've been here since 1997 and continue to grow and get stronger. #### **IWFFA Covid 19 Guidelines At the Field**

Due to the recent Covid 19 pandemic, we will be adding some additional safety features to the Kelly McGillis Classic to ensure the safety of our players and coaches.

- Women's teams will have to show their vaccination card at the registration along with your photo I.D. when you sign your team roster to register for the tournament.
- Your roster will be noted, and monitored during all games.
- Women who are NOT vaccinated MUST wear masks on the field during play.
- Women NOT vaccinated remember to keep a 6 foot distance from others.
- Kindly Respect Our Rules for the Safety of All
- We will be asking players and coaches to wash hands and or use hand sanitizer more frequently during practices and games.
- Distance yourself from others Open Up Your Huddles so you are not so close to one another
- We encourage all players to wear a lightweight, breathable buff.
- We will have a digital thermometer on site to take the temperature of all players and coaches before the start of any practice or game.
- If a player or coach has a temperature of 100.4 or greater, we will kindly and discretely ask them to leave the practice to go home and get some rest.
- IWFFA will be following all rules and regulations set out by the CDC if any of our players or coaches become ill due to Covid 19.
- Players NOT vaccinated MUST WEAR MASKS ON THE FIELD
- We will require proof of vaccination at women's registration

\*\*Do not come to the tournament if you are not feeling well.\*\*

We will continue to assess the Covid19 situation regularly and will make adjustments as needed to ensure the safety of everyone who is involved with our program. The player's safety is our top priority.



a friendly flag football game, there were so many women who came to the field with their coolers. I suggested we all stretch out, and half the women started to stretch. When I suggested the women put down their beers..... more than half of them left". In their second year, the league would host what is now known as the Kelly McGillis Classic, so that the 3 teams could get more competition. The KWWFFL now includes girls and women from Key West to Key Largo and is sanctioned by the International Women's Flag Football Association. Girls flag football is free. moms are encouraged to coach their daughters flag football team and the emphasis is on developing the athlete to be a leader, rather than the score of a game.
