LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Welcome everyone to Key West and the 32nd Annual Kelly McGillis Classic International Female Flag Football Championships.

As soon as you come into town, you must

get out on the water! Check out the companies and sail boats listed in this program. And please patronize the businesses you see in this program, because they have supported our event. Tell them you are flag football women.

I highly recommend renting a bicycle to get around town. Good exercise, no parking fees, save on gas, no need to look for parking. Yes, it will take you longer to get where your going, but you'll be stronger for your games. Monday we have a wonderful bike tour which shows you some of the history behind Key West. We've structured some crazy events for you to have fun and to take the edge off of the competition so you can make friends with the other teams. There is strength in unity and friendships are a good way to bond forever.

Kelly McGillis is here and she will be the judge for all our contests. Terri White, famous singer / actress (who's who) joins us as well not only in the judging, but likely in the singing. Two of our Afghans whom we successfully got out of Afghanistan and asylum to Mexico will be with us competing in the tournament. Najeebullah Fayez will coach the Fairvilla Loose Women's team and Najia Fayez will play on the El Salvador team (hopefully next year we'll have a full Afghan team). The three women will be our Grand Marshalls for our Kelly's Players Parade.

Mexico is here, which has been awhile and top teams from the U.S. (congratulations Rhode Island Dolphins #1 2023 team ranked in the world for women's flag football), Honduras, Guatemala, Morocco, El Salvador will converge for some fantastic flag football action. We've got our top notch officials this year. Head Official: Georgeanne Lewis will lead the way joined with other Americans: Aric Hughley, Dean and Dennis Lauria, Tom Wosko. Ron Hachhouch from Morocco, Karen Cruz (Guatemala), Juan Carlos (El Salavdor) and yours truly (that would be me). Remember, any player who is also an official can play and get paid for games she officiates. Also, players from other teams are welcome to join the loose women's team (should they need to borrow players). Of the three fields at Wicker Field Complex, two are now artificial turf fields (just redone). Players should wear leggins and long sleeve shirts for those dives. Bring two pairs of shoes, one for grass and one for the turf. Its not the end of the world, if you don't have these equipment's, but be prepared to slide and feel pain.

IWFFA did some heavy traveling this year promoting flag football, this event and empowering females of all ages. In March we sanctioned a new league in Guam. April we went to Honduras and started two new teams in a new region. IWFFA was invited by a group of humanitarian organizations in Mexico for the entire month to train female refugees, women in shelters, girls in orphanages to empower, integrate and incentivize these groups to be part of the Mexican society, and strong leaders using IWFFA 8 on 8 flag football. Trainers Nini Salinas, Paula Rojas and Gabriela Gonzalez from Central America joined myself during the month in this effort which was very successful. We traveled to Cuba twice (because it's so dire), bringing supplies such as: food, clothing, medical supplies and of course flag football equipment. Many thanks to the local Key Westers who donated all the supplies (families in the Keys are very generous), and thanks to the girls, parents and women who joined the trip to give our Cuban flag football players competition. We are trying to bring a Cuban team to next year's Kelly McGillis Classic. If you can help in some way, please do. To continue with our 2023 travels the IWFFA added a tournament in Boston, MA which



Once a women only tournament, the girls first started to compete in our Kelly McGillis Classic in 1998.(It was actually Kelly McGillis who said she would loan us her name, if we included girls in the tournament). For us winning is not empha-sized, but rather camaraderie, understanding the game, over coming the challenges on the field and having fun. We are a developmental program to build great leaders for our future and the well being of our communities, work place and each other to make a better world.

In 2009 we were incorporated into the Monroe County schools supported by then Monroe County School Superintendent: Randy Acevedo. Today the program continues and we thank School Superintendent Theresa Axford, the school board, and all the school principals and coaches in the Monroe County School system. Through the years the girls division had grown exponentially with over 300 girls competing. The IWFFA then had great diffi-culty to afford all the girls teams. So, we initiated the "Team Owner" program in 2010, which has opened the doors for all girls in the Florida Keys to play flag foot-ball for free. Schools from Key Largo to Key West compete in our annual tourna-ment and it is possible through our Team Owners who support the program today Many thanks to our 2024 Team Owners who now join our our "Winners Circle" officially at the girls awards ceremony. 

Our last tournament of the year was Guatemala which hosted the largest number of teams ever in Central America with nine competitive teams and the fiercest competition. 

PLAYER FLAG FOOTBALL CLINIC 102 (2 of 3)

We learned the basic mechanics of flag football yesterday, now let's practice some plays. We'll warm up, conduct flag football drills, then get into play calling and execution of plays. 


Chain Gang / Team Schedule – Every team is responsible to hold the chains when they are not playing and is included in the tournament schedule. You may switch chain times with another team, but both teams must confirm with tournament director. Penalty for failing to hold chains when your team is scheduled is 15 yd penalty in your next game and opposing team may decide when to apply.

Player Pre Check - Team Line-Up Prior to Game – 10 minutes before game time. We ask teams to come to field 10 minutes before game time, to line up on side line for player check (belts tight with flags on sides, proper flags, flags should be "out" position, non-metal cleats, no jewelry, long finger nails cut or taped, no pockets in pants or shorts and team roster check. We will check to ensure all players are registered with team and shirt numbers match roster. Please do not switch shirt numbers during tournament (to aid in player selection). If your team believes the opposing team has an illegal player competing, call time out and tell the head official who will check the roster.


